1.3 SUBMITTALS

- A. Submit under provisions of Division 01.
- B. Proposed Products List: Include Products specified in Division 22.
- C. Submit shop drawings and product data grouped to include complete submittals of related systems, products, and accessories in a single submittal.
- D. Mark dimensions and values in units to match those specified.

1.4 REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Conform to Florida Building Code for 2023.
- B. Plumbing: Conform to Florida Plumbing Code for 2023.
- C. Mechanical: Conform to Florida Fuel Gas Code for 2023.
- D. Fire Protection: Conform to National Fire Protection Association documents in effect in 2020.
- E. Obtain permits, and request inspections from authority having jurisdiction.

1.5 PROJECT/SITE CONDITIONS

- A. Install Work in locations shown on Drawings, unless prevented by Project conditions.

- B. Prepare drawings showing proposed rearrangement of Work to meet Project conditions, including changes to Work specified in other Sections. Obtain permission of Architect/Engineer before proceeding.

1.6 TRANSPORTATION AND HANDLING

- A. Transport and handle Products in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- B. Promptly inspect shipments to ensure that Products comply with requirements, quantities are correct, and Products are undamaged.
- C. Provide equipment and personnel to handle Products by methods to prevent soiling, disfigurement, or damage.

1.7 STORAGE AND PROTECTION

- A. Store and protect Products in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, with seals and labels intact and legible.
- B. Store sensitive Products in weather tight climate-controlled enclosures.
- C. For exterior storage of fabricated Products place on sloped supports above ground.
- D. Provide bonded off-site storage and protection when a site does not permit on-site storage or protection.
